SORTING LIKE A CHAMP

Start with sorting your waste into 3 categories:

Recyclables in BIN A

PLEASE USE CLEAR BAGS

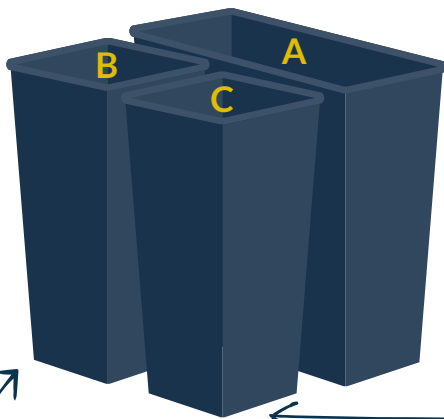
Landfill waste in BIN B

PLEASE USE BLACK BAGS

Organic waste in BIN C

USE NEWINBOSCH'S BLACK BAGS (2 FREEBIES WEEKLY)

From Q4 2024, we'll remove and process your organic waste at Newinbosch. Until then, please add it to Bin B, your landfill waste for collection by the municipality.



BIN A: RECYCLABLES

PAPER & CARDBOARD

newspapers, magazines, office paper (incl. coloured paper), envelopes, phone books, school books, cardboard, cereal boxes, food boxes, toilet rolls, cigarette boxes

ALUMINIUM & STEEL

soft drink cans, beer cans, empty food tins, bottle caps, aluminium foil

GLASS

empty glass bottles & jars, energy-saving bulbs

PLASTICS

HDBM, clear plastic, WTE (chips packets), PET (clear and coloured), polypropylene, polystyrene

Plastics marked with the numbers 1, 2, 4, 5 and 6 can be recycled:



BIN B: LANDFILL / NON-RECYCLABLES

NON-RECYCLABLE PAPER & CARDBOARD

wax-coated paper, plastic-lined take away cups

NON-RECYCLABLE GLASS

broken glass, ceramics, ovenware, vehicle windscreens, window panes, mirrors, light bulbs & laboratory glass



OTHER NON-RECYCLABLES

hygiene products (disposable nappies, sanitary products, wet wipes, tissues & other sanitary items), cosmetics, chemicals, paint, motor oil containers, acids, solvents, clothing or shoes, hazardous waste, used pens and markers, aerosol cans, batteries, expired medicines, home healthcare waste, fluorescent tubes, pesticides, electrical hardware, disposable e-cigarettes, all types of animal meat, bones & other scraps

BIN C: ORGANIC

Applicable from Q4 2024

FOOD SCRAPS

fruit and vegetable peels, eggshells, coffee grounds, tea bags (non-polyester)

GARDEN WASTE

floral trimmings, houseplants, grass clippings, leaves, small branches

OTHER

bread, grains, pasta (without sauce), nuts, seeds, soiled biodegradable materials (paper napkins, uncoated paper plates, pizza boxes with food residue) **NO MEAT PLEASE**

FUN FACT

From Q4 2024, your food scraps and garden trimmings will be collected and turned into green gold using aerated windrow composting. It's eco-friendly, efficient and smells surprisingly good!

HEROIC WASTE COLLECTION

Waste gets picked up on different days of the week to keep things squeaky clean. **Recyclables and landfill waste** have their special **Thursdays** with the municipal crew. And our vibrant neighbourhood will have its own **organic wet waste** collection days. They will swing by your neighbourhood from Q4 2024 on **Mondays** from 8am - 5pm. (More details will follow later this year.)

Got big garden waste? Drop it in the giant green bin at our Newinbosch Wet Waste Facility!

The compost we will make is like superfood for our Newinbosch gardens! It's packed with nutrients and helps keep our public spaces lush and green.

HANDLING SPECIAL WASTE



Dispose of hazardous and electronic waste responsibly to protect our ecosystem! For items like electronics, paint, chemicals and furniture, take them to the nearest Stellenbosch landfill site.

CHECKLIST

A quick recap on becoming an eco-hero:

- Ready, set, sort your waste!
- Rinse containers before adding it to the bin.
- Reduce food waste by meal planning and using leftovers creatively.
- Recycle your food scraps to reduce landfill waste and help us create nutrient-rich compost.
- Flatten bulky items like milk bottles and boxes to fit more in your bin and reduce the number of bags you use.
- Opt for reusable items like water bottles, shopping bags and containers to reduce single-use plastic waste.
- Have your bags ready for collection on the right days.
- Handle hazardous and bulk waste like a pro!



DID YOU KNOW?

Did you know that by 2050, global waste is expected to hit a whopping 3.4 billion tonnes per year?

That's more than twice the population growth rate in the same time period! And get this, every year, around 10 million metric tons of plastic end up polluting our beautiful oceans.
